



Canada to extend life of Bell CH-146 Griffon helicopters to 2031

Ottawa plans to refurbish its fleet of 85 Bell CH-146 Griffon utility helicopters to extend the aircraft's life until at least 2031. The Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF) said that Bell Helicopter Textron Canada will be undertaking the design and development work necessary to upgrade the helicopter's avionics systems, engines, cockpit displays and integrated sensor systems.

Pratt & Whitney Canada says it has been selected to replace the engines on the fleet with its PT6T 9 TwinPac, which is equipped with an engine electronic control system.

The design and development work is valued at up to C\$90 million (US\$67.4 million) and will be performed under the existing support contract for the CH-146, which was awarded to Bell in 2011, says the government. Once the initial design phase is complete, a separate contract is expected to be awarded to begin the life extension work in 2022, says the Ottawa.

The overall value of the Griffon Life Extension programme will be about \$800 million (US\$600 million). "A tactical transport helicopter capability is absolutely critical to the success of the full range of military operations..."

Future of IAF's Jaguars uncertain as high cost plagues engine upgrade plan

The plan to extend the service life of the Indian Air Force's (IAF's) Jaguar fleet, by equipping 80 of the fighters with new engines, is in trouble. Indian planners believe Honeywell, which is the sole vendor in the project, is demanding an exorbitant price to replace the Jaguar's existing Rolls-Royce engines.

Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd (HAL), which is leading the project, has written to Honeywell protesting its "high and unacceptable quote", which HAL says will "kill" the plan to re-engine the Jaguar. IAF, HAL and Honeywell sources confirm the US firm has quoted \$2.4 billion for 180 engines – which include 160 engines for 80 twin-engine Jaguars, and 20 spare engines. That amounts to \$13.3 million (Rs 95 crore) per engine. That has taken the cost of "re-engining" each Jaguar to a prohibitive Rs 210 crore, including Rs 20 crore per aircraft that HAL will charge to integrate the new engines...

India : HAL to overhaul more Sukhoi-30 jets

The Centre has decided to increase the overhauling of Sukhoi-30 fighter jets from 12 to 25 a year, said Union minister of state for defence Subash Bhamre on Thursday. The manufacture and overhaul of such fighter jets are carried out at the Nashik division of the state-owned Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL).

The minister was speaking to reporters at the launch of the defence innovation hub here. Bhamre rejected allegations that HAL does not have enough work orders and that it was ignored in the Rafale aircraft manufacturing deal. "That the PSU will not have any work orders after 2019 are baseless," he claimed. To buttress his claims, the Union minister said that at present, HAL has work orders worth Rs 28,000 crore. "Moreover, additional orders worth Rs 73,000 crore are in the pipeline. This includes manufacturing of fourth generation fighter aircraft Tejas worth Rs 50,000 crore..."
