



## Polish Military to Modernize Its Mi-24 Fleet

Polish Ministry of Defence is getting ready to upgrade its fleet of the Mi-24 helicopters. Both variants of the aircraft in question - Mi-24D and Mi-24W - would undergo the modernization. The Armament Inspectorate announced that a technical dialogue has begun with regards to upgrades of the Mi-24 helicopters.

The whole procedure is aimed at assessing whether the modernized aircraft would meet the initial requirements defined within the scope of their armament, communication, self-protection, navigation and electronic countermeasures. Furthermore, it is assumed that cost of acquisition,

operational use and decommissioning of the equipment, as well as the timeline for the whole process, are all going to be estimated as a part of the procedure. This also concerns the requirements related to logistics, handing off and supervision with regards to the equipment received.

The dialogue is to last from July until September but the term may be extended if the goals are not accomplished. Submissions will be accepted until 8th February. Alongside the contractual data, the application shall also include a declaration on being in possession of experience in the area of "maintaining, repairing...

## F-35 Far from Ready to Face Current or Future Threats, Testing Data Shows

The Navy's version of the F-35 Joint Strike Fighter, recently declared ready for combat, has netted unacceptably low "fully mission capable" rates—meaning it's in fact almost never fully ready for combat—according to a document obtained by the Center for Defense Information at the Project On Government Oversight (POGO).

The fact that the Navy is pushing ahead with the aircraft in spite of evidence that it is not ready for combat and could therefore put at risk missions, as well as the troops who depend on it to get to the fight, comes at the same time as the Pentagon's annual operational testing report for fiscal year 2018 shows that the entire F-35 program, the most expensive weapon system in history, is not ready to face current or future threats.

Sold in 2001 as a cheap multi-role fighter at a promised \$38 million per plane, the troubled F-35, now at an average \$158.4 million per copy...

### South Korea : BAE Challenges Lockheed Martin for F-16 Upgrade Work

BAE Systems is competing against Lockheed Martin to be the prime contractor for Korea's forthcoming upgrade of some 130 F-16s. Attention has focused largely on the competition between Northrop Grumman and Raytheon to supply the AESA radar. But the Korean request for proposals also invited non-OEMs to bid as system integrator.

Taiwan and the U.S. are also planning a similar upgrade to some 140 and 300 aircraft, respectively. Other F-16 operators may follow, making this a multibillion-dollar market. BAE claims long experience in supplying avionics and electronics for the F-16. It has provided head-up displays, electronic warfare systems, reconnaissance sensors, flight control computers, terrain avoidance systems, IFF transponders, Link 16 communications and other items. The company designed and has installed a new commercial fire control computer (CFCC) in 270 U.S. Air National Guard F-16C/D...
