



## Eurofighter ready to deliver long-term enhancement 'menu' to operators

The Eurofighter industry consortium remains on course to deliver a broad-ranging "menu" of capability options to its core partner nations before year-end to inform their decisions on the type's long-term evolution (LTE) path.

"We have done a lot of technical definition work with the customers, giving them a range of options," Paul Smith, Typhoon operational requirements manager for Eurofighter partner company BAE Systems Air, tells FlightGlobal. These range from performing a technical refresh of the Typhoon's current capabilities to a full update, replacing the type's entire avionics and system

architecture. Smith says industry expects programme partners Germany, Italy, Spain and the UK to instead opt for a middle option. "The gist is a very large-area display, with no HUD [head-up display], fully utilising the [BAE] Striker II helmet, and refreshing the communications and data storage and high-speed data networks, improving the ability to share and move data rapidly."

Engine and flight-control system enhancements could seek to boost the fuel-efficiency of the type's Eurojet EJ200 turbofans, in conjunction with the use of an aerodynamic modification kit. Additionally, the use of...

In a stormy two-hour hearing, members of the House Oversight Committee lambasted Lockheed Martin and Pentagon officials for putting pilots at risk of accidents by failing to fix the F-35's troubled maintenance system. "Fix this now, before you have blood on your hands," said Rep. Rashida Talib.

Criticism and concern came from both sides of the aisle, although Democrats were particularly harsh — especially regarding Lockheed Martin's performance and what they allege is an unwillingness on the part of the defense giant to pay back the government for problematic F-35 parts. "We cannot simply hope that these accidents never occur. These problems must be addressed," said the committee chair, Rep. Carolyn Maloney.

"The US government is a major client of Lockheed Martin. In 2019 alone, Lockheed expected to earn \$41 billion in revenue from the US government, business paid for by the American taxpayers....

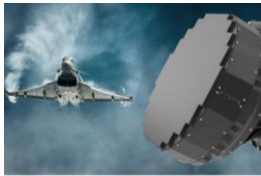

Les dix premiers Rafale produits au début des années 2000 étaient au standard appelé F1. Ils étaient dotés uniquement de capacité air-air et de ravitaillement en vol.

L'opération de retrofit de ces avions consiste à les modifier en profondeur pour leur donner les mêmes capacités que les avions de standard F3, actuellement produits.

BAE Systems is competing against Lockheed Martin to be the prime contractor for Korea's forthcoming upgrade of some 130 F-16s. Attention has focused largely on the competition between Northrop Grumman and Raytheon to supply the AESA radar. But the Korean request for proposals also invited non-OEMs to bid as system integrator.

Taiwan and the U.S. are also planning a similar upgrade to some 140 and 300 aircraft, respectively. Other F-16 operators may follow, making this a multibillion-dollar market. BAE claims long experience in supplying avionics and electronics for the F-16. It has provided head-up displays, electronic warfare systems, reconnaissance sensors, flight control computers, terrain avoidance systems, IFF transponders, Link 16 communications and other items. The company designed and has installed a new commercial fire control computer (CFCC) in 270 U.S. Air National Guard F-16C/D...
