



Boeing, Honeywell and Rolls-Royce Deutschland partner to service H-47 Chinook engines

Boeing, Honeywell Aerospace and Rolls-Royce Deutschland Ltd. have reached an agreement to provide in-service support of the T-55 engine should the government of Germany select the H-47 Chinook for its Schwerer Transporthubschrauber (STH) heavy-lift helicopter requirement.

Since the forming of the Chinook Germany Industry Team in 2018, originally comprised of nine German companies, Boeing continues to build a strong industry team to provide the Luftwaffe with local long-term services support, maintenance and training of the Chinook over the next several decades. In addition, Boeing's industrial plan will

foster German economic growth while creating highly skilled jobs in country. "The partnership between Honeywell, Rolls-Royce Deutschland and our industry team members provides an established local supply base for around-the-clock parts availability, NATO interoperability and streamlined aircraft maintenance procedures," said Michael Hostetter, vice president of Boeing Defense, Space & Security in Germany.



AMC to Evaluate Interim KC-46 Fix While Pressing for Permanent New Remote Vision System

The Air Force in the coming weeks will evaluate an interim fix to the KC-46's troubled remote vision system to see if there would be any value gained, while still holding Boeing to its requirement to provide a broad, permanent fix to the system by 2023. In April, Boeing and the Air Force announced an agreement on fixing the remote vision system—a collection of cameras and sensors linking the boom operator in the front of the aircraft to the boom system to refuel aircraft.

The system has long been troubled by unclear and skewed images, in turn causing the boom to strike outside of a receiving aircraft's receptacle. The Air Force has said this is the biggest problem on the aircraft, and without a fix the Pegasus cannot be operational.

Air Mobility Command boss Gen. Jacqueline D. Van Ovest recently visited Boeing, and saw progress on the RVS replacement, called RVS 2.0. The replacement includes...

Bulgaria worries about the return of modernized Su-25 from Belarus

The Belarusian aircraft repair enterprise 558th Aviation Plant in Baranovichi will return the first two modernized Bulgarian Su-23 attack aircraft to Bulgaria on September 25, Capital reports citing the specialized aviation publication Aero. The source confirmed the information, specifying that the two flying machines should return to Bulgaria by the end of the month.

Sofia signed a contract to extend the flight life and modernize eight Su-25 aircraft permanently based at the Bezmer military airfield. The amount of the contract is about 99 million leva (1 lev - about 46 rubles).

For this money, the resource of attack aircraft should be extended for at least 8 years. However, Bulgaria is worried about the return of combat aircraft from Belarus, because Alexander Lukashenko said last Thursday about the possible closure of the borders of Belarus due to ongoing protests, as...
